Property assessment invoices for 2012 were mailed at the end of December. Payments are due no later than March 1, 2012 without penalty. If you have not received an invoice, please call the POA office at (803) 641-9663.

Throughout the past month, the POA has received, along with assessment payments, several suggestions regarding ways to trim the budget here at the POA

We understand your frustration when you opened that envelope and saw that there had been an increase in the yearly assessment. You were all probably thinking we are just another company that has raised their prices. Unfortunately, we are not immune to the raising costs of doing business that has swept the nation for several years now. We were forced to look for an increase in revenue to support the current aesthetics and required services to maintain the attractiveness of Woodside Plantation.

As a board, it would have given us great pleasure to be able to tell all of our property owners that the assessment would remain the same as the previous year, regrettably and responsibly that was not feasible for this year. The decrease in the number of new construction and homeowner's improvement has had an impact on the POA's revenue, and consequently we were forced to look for additional income to meet our obligations to you, the property owners, while not compromising our level of services.

We are all hopeful that the New Year will bring about a more stable economy and positive growth to the Plantation. We are optimistic that with the recent opening of several new business in this area, companies see the profitability of this area and the potential for growth which should have a positive impact on the value of Woodside as long as we are committed to the aesthetics and services of the POA that are required to keep it as a community that attracts both newcomers to the area as well as true Aikenites, and protects all property owners' investments.

In closing, please be aware that the board of directors' decision to increase the assessment this year was not made in haste nor irresponsibility. As spokesman for my fellow board members, I can assure you that we will continue to evaluate all your suggestions and you can be confident that any decisions made by the board are based on our commitment to the best interest of the Plantation and you, the property owners.

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COMMON AREA LANDSCAPING

The WPPOA office gets constant complaints from residents (your neighbors) about debris left in the streets. Not only is this unsightly, but it is unsafe. Many of the roads in Woodside are barely two lanes and very winding. When the roads get clogged with debris, they become one lane, with limited visibility.

So, here's another "Did you know...?" Did you know that commercial landscapers are required to dispose of landscaping debris? They are not allowed to blow it into the streets or storm drains. This is per Woodside covenants and the City of Aiken solid waster ordinance. When a landscaper purchases a Woodside vendor decal and comes to work in Woodside, he/she receives a list of the Woodside landscaper regulations. Therefore, your landscaper knows not to leave debris in the streets. Feel free to remind him/her, if necessary.

The Woodside covenants say that residents may leave their trash and debris by the curb (not in the street) in front of their houses (not on any other property or vacant lot) no earlier than Tuesday noon, for Wednesday pick up. We do try to be sensitive to those folks who do their own landscaping and have limited time in which to do it. If you are doing a once or twice a year major clean up on a day other than Tuesday, you have a couple of options:

- Leave the debris in the backyard or behind some trees in your yard, then put it out by the curb Tuesday afternoon
- Call the City for a special pickup. Yard debris qualifies for a special pickup as it would be more than the "norm" as far as debris is concerned. There is a charge for this type of pickup but the City is willing to come out and provide you an estimate.
- Leave the debris by your curb, as discreetly as possible. Then call the WPPOA office and let them know. This may save you from a complaint letter and fine.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Pat Shippey

Time is running out. Your 2012 annual assessment is due **no later than March 1, 2012** without penalty. Through the end of January about 13% of the annual assessment had been received. This is about half of what was received at this time last year.

The 2012 budget was included with the assessment notice. To answer some of the most commonly asked questions about the budget, here are some facts. There are currently 1,804 dwellings and 517 sold lots within Woodside Plantation. In addition to property owners, the Development Company pays an assessment on each of its unsold lots and also on any spec homes. Each country club is also assessed based on the number of golf holes it owns.

The landscape budget increased due to full year responsibility for areas acquired in 2011 and in anticipation of new areas to be turned over in 2012. There was an increase in the security budget due primarily to increased employer expenses especially for increased premiums for unemployment insurance. All other budget estimates for the other areas remain about the same.

There are no major road repair projects anticipated for 2012 and the board elected to contribute 10% of assessments to the designated Reserve fund for future repairs. With the cost of oil increasing and future repairs becoming more expensive, it is important to maintain reserves at a level to be able to maintain the quality of the community and protect property values without any future "special assessments." Board members always keep in mind that the two main reasons communities such as Woodside fail and decline are 1) non-enforcement of the covenants and 2) inadequate reserves.

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD

Dee Clark

ARB Board Members – Volunteers

Moving forward into 2012, your ARB volunteers are very active and committed to dealing with the day to day issues of change and development within the plantation. Our board currently consists of seven members covering four areas of responsibility including Landscaping, Plan Review, Trees and Satellites, and Inspections.

When you submit a request for approval individuals assigned to that area of responsibility conduct a site visit to determine the feasibility of the request and potential issues that might arise from either the new construction or renovation to the existing property.

The landscape members are responsible for the review of all landscape plans, whether they are for new construction or an improvement, and the inspection of all new construction landscape installations. A final inspection is conducted to ensure that the approved plan has been implemented and there are no issues remaining on the property that need to be remedied.

New construction plans require intense review to insure all areas of development plans are properly met from color samples of siding, shingles and trim to setbacks, square footage and roof slopes. The ARB also conducts a final

inspection of the property to insure all areas of conformance with the plans including landscaping, driveways and clean up.

Monthly inspections of all lots under construction are performed by ARB members to address issues of construction debris, untidy sites, and erosion. Contractors are notified in writing regarding violations.

Approval for removal of trees larger than four inches in diameter is required, and a site visit from the ARB is conducted. For a satellite installation request, the ARB member determines by the use of a satellite locator where possible signals are available and notes them on the approval form. Also noted is the need for shrubbery to soften the visibility of the satellite support pole.

The ARB board meets on the second and fourth Mondays of every month to discuss the requests for approval and votes on acceptance or denial. The meetings also cover resolution of any complaints, violations and other issues that have been brought to the attention of the POA and are under the jurisdiction of the ARB.

ARB members are dedicated to their board duties and give willingly of their time to ensure that Woodside remains an aesthetically pleasing neighborhood.

LAKES & DAMS

Aquatic Services: Granite Ridge Aquatic Services (GRAS) has reported the following actions:

Royal Lake: has a small amount of Alligator weed, winter cold will control.

Burden Lake: has a small amount of Floating Hearts; winter cold weather will kill it.

Magnolia Lake: has a small amount of Floating Hearts; winter cold will kill it back.

Holley Lake: no problems noted.

Oakman Lake: no problems noted.

If you notice specific problems, please notify me or the WPPOA office.

Security: There have been reports of bait traps missing from property owner's back yards near or in the lakes. Please report trespassers to security or the WPPOA office. These are your lakes and we all pay to maintain them. Thanks for your help.

Lakes & Dam Maintenance: As of this writing, Aiken County is over thirteen inches below normal rainfall. After the winter rains start to fall, we should see an increase in lake levels; this should improve the appearance of the lakes and help the fishermen. Our contractor has started to clear the dam outfall areas to remove vegetation from the discharge areas. This is required to keep vegetation from damaging the outfall pipes and downstream sides of the dams.

Fishing: First Fishing Outing of 2012

Attention all fishermen: The first fishing outing of 2012 is set for March 17 at Magnolia Lake from 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. First and second place prizes will be awarded for catching the longest bass in nightcrawler, minnow and artificial bait categories. In addition, there will be a prize for the person who catches the first and last bass during the three hour outing. All fishing must be done from the shoreline and there is no entry fee for this outing. Woodside's lakes have excellent fishing during the spring months. We have a number of experienced fishermen that are willing to assist you if you wanted to get started properly.

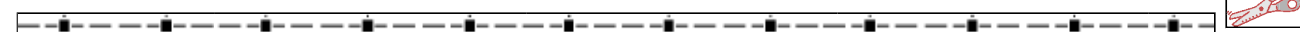
